

July 9, 2014 NISHOF Committee Minutes

Brian called the meeting to order at 7:17 at Manny's in Savanna. There were 22 members in attendance.

We said the Pledge to the Flag.

The Secretaries report was distributed and read. There were no corrections or additions and the minutes were approved unanimously.

Marv gave the Treasurers report which showed expenses of \$565.48 which was mostly from the All-Star games. That left us with a total of \$3,860.66 in the account. However, Marv had \$160 that was not yet deposited and another approximately \$450 was turned in before the meeting. We still need to get many sponsors for our banquet. All donations need to be turned in to Brian by September 15 in order for the donors to be listed in the banquet program.

Bud Bull made a special request that we add a church team from Savanna to this year's Honor Teams. It was a team that had a record of 23-0 in the 1955-1956 season. He expected that this would add about 30-40 people at the banquet. Bud was concerned that with the many years that have gone by since the played, that many would no longer be with us in another few years. A motion was made to add them to this year's inductees. The motion passed unanimously. Bud thanked everyone for this and for being members of this committee.

Regarding the banquet, the ticket price was officially adopted at \$20 per ticket. Tickets were distributed to those in attendance at the end of the meeting. All unsold tickets should be returned to Brian by September 10 which is the date of our next meeting. Any member needing additional tickets can get them at that time.

Tony reported on the All-Star games. The crowd was small but the players had a great time and everything went smoothly! Larry took pictures and Jim has them on the website.

A motion was made to accept Honor team nominations at the September meeting and vote on them at the November 5th meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Brian reminded everyone that we will have a special meeting October 1, to check on any unaccounted for tickets and to take care of last minute items for the banquet. The meeting should be relatively short.

Brian also reminded everybody that the banquet is October 18 with Happy Hour starting at 5:45 and Dinner at 6:30.

Dave reported that his inductee from last year has had the football field named after him where he has coached in Wisconsin.

During comment time, Joe asked about all inductees from every town. Jim said we should send a letter of thanks to all banquet donors. Paul reminded everyone to bring their money and extra tickets to the September meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 8:09PM Central Daylight time.
